The WKC Competition License Committee considers past racing experience when it grants competition licenses. Those applicants with no motor racing experience will be automatically assigned entry-level licenses as follows. **All competitors with new licenses will be on probation until they demonstrate to the race director they can run at competitive speed and are safe drivers.**

If you have no sanctioned kart racing or other motor racing experience and are
8-11 years old you will be granted a “K” license,
12-15 years old you will be granted a “J” license,
15 and up you will be granted an “N” license.

No Sanctioned Motor Racing experience. Check this box if kart racing will be your first experience in motor racing. You need not fill out the rest of this form.

Briefly describe your motor racing experience.
